## Raga of the month February, 2020

## Salagvarali

The name sounds to be of Carnatic origin. However, the Raga was composed and delineated by Acharya S N Ratanjankar. It has been described in his book Abhinav Geet Manjari (Volume 3). In the book he mentions, that he discovered many years later, after introducing this Raga, that there was a mention of Raga Meghanad in the Ragadhyaya of the book SangeetaParijat which resembled Raga Salagvarali. The Raga can be classified under Melakartha no. 46- Shadvidhamargini in Carnatic Music and Thata "Khatamarg" in Hindustani Music.

Pandit Mahale explains, "Varali in Carnatic Music is synonymous with Todi, <u>SALAGA</u> (सालग) indicates that there is a *laga* (लाग) combination of Todi with another Raga- in this case Kafi. SrgrS and PrgrS are phrases of Todianga and phrase PDnS" in *Uttaranga* clearly indicates Kafi." The details of the Raga given in the book are as follows:

<u>Notes used</u>- S r g P D n; <u>Madhyam</u> is <u>Varjit</u> and <u>Nishad</u> is weak in <u>Aroha;</u> <u>Vadi</u>- **P**;<u>Samvadi</u>- **S**;<u>Gaansamaya</u>- 2<sup>nd</sup> <u>prahar</u> of the day-10 am to 1pm; <u>Aroha</u>- S r g P, D, n D P, S''; <u>Avaroha</u>- S'' n D P, DnDP, g P, r g r S; <u>Pakada</u> (पकड) <u>(Distinctive Tonal Phrases)</u>-S, rgrS, rgP, DP, nDP, DP, gP, rgrS;

<u>Brief Swaravistar</u>: Srgr, grS, S'n'D'P, 'P'D'n'D'P, S, P-g->r, gP, rgrS; Srgr, gPDg, PnD,P, PDnD,PDP, PDnS'', nD, PDnD, PDP, g, grgP, DPg, P-g, Pr, grS;
