Raga Manavi is a melodious but little known Raga and it is based on a Carnatic Raga having the same name. It is a hexatonic Raga and its scale consists of notes S, R, g, P, D and n. It belongs to Kafi Thata i.e. Melakarta No. 22 Kharaharapriya. The Raga in Poorvanga resembles Raga Shivranjani and Raga Kafi in Uttaranga. The scale of the Raga can be obtained by adding komal Nishad –n- to Raga Shivranjani.
