Raga of the Month- February, 2015-

Latangi/ DhanashriKalyan/Dhatuvardhini.

Raga Latangi belongs to *Melakarta* No. 63 Lathangi. It uses Sa, ri, gi, mi, Pa, dha, nu; that is *teevra* Madhyam, *komal* Dhaivat and all other Shuddha *Swaras*-RGmPdN. A simple glance at the scale of the Raga, it will be noticed that the Raga is a combination of, Yaman (or Kalyan) in the *Poorvanga* and PooriaDhanashri in the *Uttaranga*. In some old treatises the scale of Poorvi Thata (Kamavardhini Mela No. 51) was called as Dhanashri. The name DhanashriKalyan perhaps has its roots in that reference. {Commonly known Raga Dhanashri is classified under Thata Kafi (Mela No. 22 Kharaharpriya) having komal g and n}. In switching Rishabhs and Dhaivats, in Raga Latangi, we sacrifice the natural *Shadja-Madhyama and Shadja-Pancham samvad* (consonance) present in Yaman (R-P and R-D) and (r-m and r-d); which affects *ranjakatva* (degree of delight or melodic pleasure) that a listener derives.
